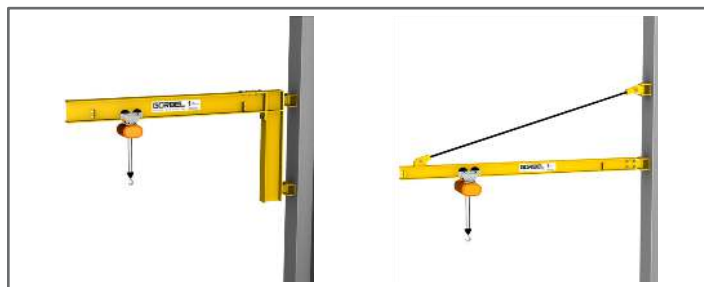

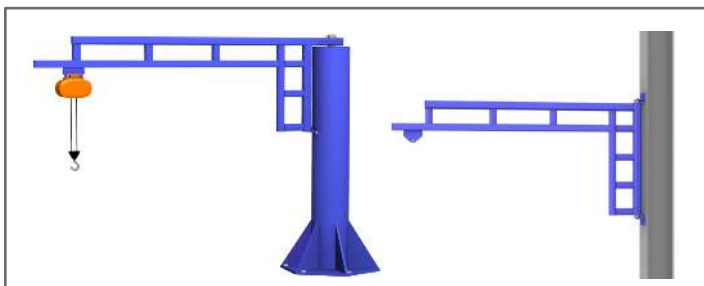
FREE STANDING JIB CRANES

Free standing jib cranes are the most common jib crane application. They can help you lift for nearly any application.



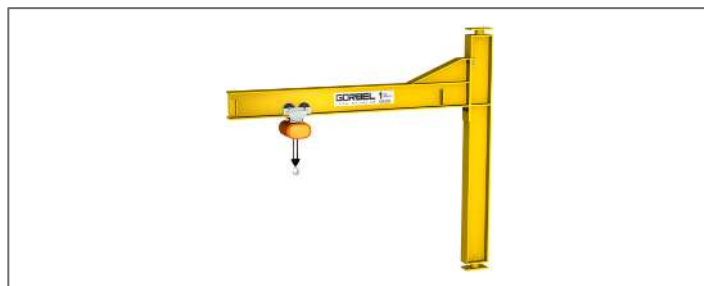
WALL OR COLUMN JIB CRANES

Wall or column mounted jibs are a great option when you have limited floor space. These jibs take great advantage of existing infrastructure.



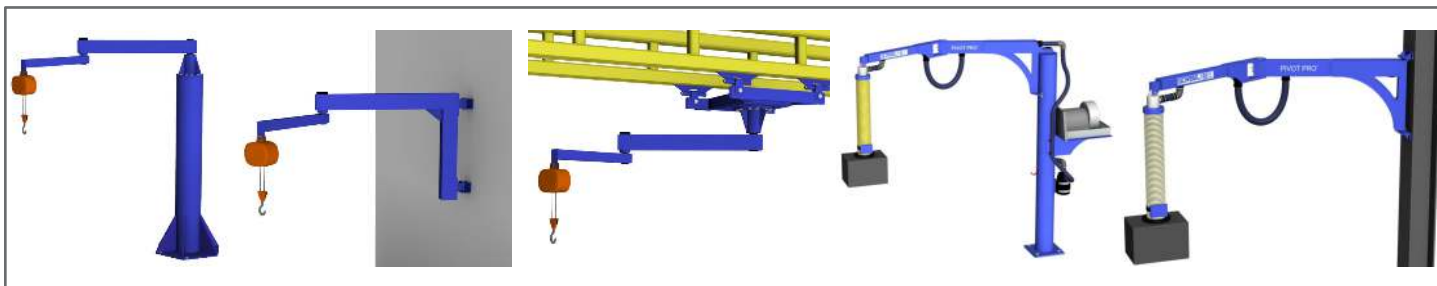
WORKSTATION JIB CRANES
