ADVANTAGES OF DOUBLE GIRDER CRANES

- Greater maximum span and capacity
- Extra hook height
- Ideal for lifting heavy equipment and frequent heavy loads
- Special features such as walkways, operator cabs, and lights can be added and supported



DISADVANTAGES OF A DOUBLE GIRDER CRANE

- Greater end approach distance on both trolley and bridge travel
- More expensive due to additional material and labor to produce
- Installation is more complex and therefore more expensive than single girder.



ADVANTAGES OF SINGLE GIRDER CRANES

- Easier installation, service and maintenance
- Lower production costs
- Usually the most cost-effective option for light to medium duty cranes
- Works well for buildings where headroom is limited
- Lower overall weight can reduce support structure cost or can be supported by existing building structure



DISADVANTAGES OF A SINGLE GIRDER CRANE

- Walkways and operator cabs are more difficult to include
- Reduced hook height compared to double girder cranes
- Limited to 20 ton capacity
